ACCESSIBLE READERS: FICTION

READING AGES: The level the reader is reading at, regardless of actual age. This dictates the amount of copy on each page and complexity of sentence structure.

INTEREST AGES: The actual age of the reader. This dictates the topic choice (more friendly at the lower bands, more edgy at the higher bands) and complexity of vocab choices.

CURRENT READING AGE PARAMETERS:

- Reading age 6 up to 30 words per page with simple sentences.
- Reading age 7 up to 40 words per page with simple sentences where possible.


